## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE CORPORATION

A meeting of the Board of Directors (Board) of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) was held on September 18, 2013, in Room G28D, 6501 Beacon Drive, Kansas City, MO. The public was invited to attend the open session portion of the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 12:45 am on September 18, 2013 in open session.
