Due to deficiencies with submissions of annual maintenance materials, and after repeated opportunities to correct errors and resolve issues to the Board's satisfaction, the Board is withdrawing approval and directing RMA to assume annual maintenance for the High Amylose Corn product to ensure the interest of producers and tax payers are protected as required by law.
