SUBJECT: Fresh Market Bean plan of insurance

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors (FCIC Board) approved the Fresh Market Bean plan of insurance on July 30, 2009, beginning with the 2011 crop year. The Fresh Market Bean plan of insurance is a privately developed product that was submitted to the FCIC Board under section 508(h) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act by the North Carolina Snap Bean Growers and the North Carolina Department of Agriculture. The Fresh Market Bean plan of insurance will be available for sale in the following states and counties:

New York: Allegany, Cayuga, Genesee, Herkimer, Monroe, Oneida, Orleans, Steuben, and Yates Counties

North Carolina: Chowan, Hyde, Tyrrell, and Washington Counties

Virginia: Accomack and Northampton Counties
