SUBJECT: Actual Production History Olive Program

**BACKGROUND:**

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors (FCIC Board) approved the Actual Production History (APH) Olive Program on September 22, 2011. Beginning with the 2012 crop year, insurance coverage will be available to olive growers in 12 California counties. The APH-Olive Program is a two-year production-based policy with specific features addressing the issue of alternate bearing production.
