## **February 15 Sales Closing Date Near For Crop Insurance in Alabama**

VALDOSTA, Ga., January 28, 2014 - The USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds farmers of the **February 15** sales closing date for crop insurance. This sales closing date applies to crop insurance policies for fresh market sweet corn in Baldwin County only. The sales closing date is the last day to buy a new policy or change an existing policy's coverage level.

Crop insurance is sold and delivered solely through private crop insurance agents. Contact a local crop insurance agent for more information about the program.
