## **Processing Tomato Crop Insurance Expands in Indiana and Michigan**

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Dec. 16, 2013 – The USDA’s Risk Management Agency (RMA) recently expanded processing tomato coverage under the Federal crop insurance program. Producers interested in buying a policy must do so by the March 15, 2014, sales closing date.

Processing tomato insurance is now available in Bartholomew, Carroll, Cass, Clinton, Delaware, Grant, Henry, Howard, Jackson, La Porte, Lake, Madison, Miami, Porter, Randolph, Rush, Shelby, St. Joseph, Tippecanoe, Tipton, Wabash, and Wells counties in Indiana. It is also available in Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Lenawee, Monroe and St. Joseph counties in Michigan.

Yield protection is offered through this Actual Production History (APH) insurance plan. Producers can choose catastrophic risk protection (CAT Coverage) or buy-up coverage ranging from 50 to 75 percent.

Crop insurance is sold and delivered solely through private crop insurance agents. Contact a local crop insurance agent for more information about the program.
