SUBJECT: Wheat Sprout Damage - Salvage Markets

**BACKGROUND**

Weather conditions have made sprout damage a threat to this year's wheat crop in Colorado, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska.

In accordance with Paragraph 1102 (H) of The Loss Adjustment Manual Standards Handbook (FCIC-25010), the Topeka Regional Office is providing a list of damaged grain buyers.
