## **Final Planting Date Maps Published for Spring Crops in Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin**

SAINT PAUL, Minn., February 11, 2014 - The USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) announced updated final planting date maps for spring crops in the states of Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin. The final planting date maps show the final planting dates for each crop by county. For crops with multiple final planting dates, colors are used to identify which final planting date is associated with each county. This can be a useful tool for producers when planning their planting schedule.
