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## **2015 Crop Year Actuarial Document Changes Released for Spring Crops in Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin**

SAINT PAUL, Minn., Dec. 9, 2014 — USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) announced that updates are now available for all commodities and insurance plans with a November 30 contract change date for the 2015 crop year in Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin.
