William J. Murphy is Administrator of the Risk Management Agency (RMA), U.S. Department of Agriculture, which provides economic protection and risk management tools to America's farmers and ranchers primarily through federally sponsored crop insurance delivered and serviced by private insurance companies. In this capacity, he is also Manager of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC), and a non-voting member of the FCIC Board of Directors.

Murphy has spent over 30 years in the Federal crop insurance community and he brings hands-on expertise and executive management to RMA's lead position. He most recently served as RMA Acting Administrator during the transition to the Obama Administration. Before that, he served RMA as the Deputy Administrator for Insurance Services; Director of the Regional Office in Davis, Calif., overseeing crop insurance operations in California, Utah, Nevada, Arizona and Hawaii; and Director of the Western Region Compliance Office.

A native of Pennsylvania, Mr. Murphy holds a Bachelor of Science degree with an emphasis in Agronomy and Farm Management from Pennsylvania State University.
