SUBJECT: Regional Irrigation Assessments

BACKGROUND: The Loss Adjustment Manual (LAM), FCIC 25010, requires the Risk Management Agency (RMA) Regional Offices (RO) to issue Regional Irrigation Assessments to identify areas which are suspected of having inadequate irrigation water supplies. The attached irrigation assessments are provided:

- Bosque, Callahan, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Erath, Hood, Somervell, and Stephens counties, Texas - Oklahoma City RO,
- Pinal County, Arizona - Davis RO,
- Glacier, Golden Valley, Meagher, Musselshell, Teton, Valley and Wheatland counties, Montana, and Crook and Weston counties, Wyoming - Billings RO, and
- Jewell, Republic, Clay and Cloud counties, Kansas - Topeka RO.

To continue the proper administration of the irrigated practice for insured crops, insurance providers are directed to the LAM, Section 6, PAR 51 and the review requirements in Manual 14, Guidelines and Expectations for Delivery of the Federal Crop Insurance Program, FCIC 14010.
