The 2001 price support levels as defined in the Guaranteed Tobacco Crop Provisions 99-071 for purposes within Section 12(c)(iii)(A) and Section 12(d)(3) are listed below:

54-55	235 Cigar Binder Tobacco	\$1.25

The 2001 support price for type 31 tobacco (crop code 231-quota burley) as defined in the Quota Tobacco Crop Provisions 99-070 for purposes listed in Section 13(b)(1) and in Section 13(c)(iii)(A) and (B) is \$1.83 per pound. The \$0.06 per pound warehouse fee is no longer deducted.
