MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE CORPORATION

A meeting of the Board of Directors (Board) of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) was held September 20-22, via videoconference, in-person and phone. The public was invited to attend the open session portion of the meeting. Meeting September 20-22, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 am on September 21, 2022, and again at 9:15 am on September 22, 2022.

Call to Order Open Session

The Board immediately went into executive session to discuss confidential matters with Risk Management Agency (RMA) staff and submitters of private products under section 508(h) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act (Act).
