#### INFORMATIONAL MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Following Another Crop Blanket Written Agreement (Standardized

Written Agreement) Details for the Topeka Region

### I. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

On December 22, 2022, Informational Memorandum <u>IS-22-003</u> was issued to detail actions RMA is taking as part of a broader set of commitments made last spring by President Biden and Secretary Vilsack to increase domestic food production amid potential global food shortages related to the invasion of Ukraine. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is simplifying and expanding options to insure double crop acreage in areas that do not offer coverage. This will enable agricultural producers to produce two crops on the same land each year, such as spring planted soybeans or grain sorghum following the harvest of a crop such as winter wheat.

In support of the President's and Secretary's commitments, the Topeka Regional Office (TRO) expanded the availability of insurance options for Following Another Crop (FAC) soybeans and grain sorghum in 2023. Please see maps on the <u>TRO Underwriting Guidelines</u> webpage for the county availability and options for insurance FAC soybeans and grain sorghum.

This memo provides details on one of those insurance options - a new, innovative approach for offering FAC soybeans and grain sorghum - the Blanket Written Agreement (Standardized Written Agreement), or "BL Offers". BL Offers for irrigated soybeans and grain sorghum will be available in select counties in Kansas for the 2023 crop year. See Section III for a list of counties that BL Offers are available. (Note that non-irrigated FAC soybeans and grain sorghum will not be insurable in the 2023 crop year under this memo).

### II. FAC Written Agreement Options and Requirements

In each of the selected counties, separate BL Offers are available for irrigated soybeans and grain sorghum. A BL Offer is a standardized written agreement offer prebuilt by RMA into the Regional Office Exceptions (ROE) System which allows for

a producer to choose to insure their irrigated FAC soybeans or grain sorghum. Since the written agreement offer is prebuilt by RMA, a producer does not have to go through an extensive underwriting process and can simply choose to insure their FAC crop by submitting the request with an actuarial change request (ACR) form through their agent and Approved Insurance Provider (AIP).

Each county has a unique written agreement number for both soybeans and grain sorghum that AIPs can access. The BL in each county provides the terms and conditions of insurance available to producers interested in insuring irrigated FAC soybeans or grain sorghum in select counties in Kansas for the 2023 crop year. The rates and T-yields for the FAC practice may vary by county just as they do for other insurable crops.

For all FAC [crop] insured under BL, the definition for FAC applies:

FAC (Following Another Crop): A planted crop following:

- 1. A perennial hay crop that was harvested in the same calendar year; and
- 2. A crop (other than a cover crop) that has reached the headed or budded stage prior to termination, regardless of the percentage of plants that reached the headed or budded stage;

Termination means growth has ended. A crop that follows a cover crop that meets the criteria outlined in the Insurance Availability section of the Special Provisions is considered NFAC.

## III. Blanket Written Agreement (Standardized Written Agreement) Offer Numbers

BL Offers were used previously with breeched levees, which is where the BL designator originated. See Exhibit A for BL Offer numbers for each county and each crop where they are offered.

### IV. Action

Insured's can select a BL Offer by submitting a signed and dated ACR form for irrigated soybeans and or irrigated grain sorghum to their crop insurance agent by the sales closing date. The request type code is "BL" and should include applicable crop types and practices. AIPs process the BL Offers as they would a pre-approved and accepted written agreement, attaching the BL WA number to the insured's policy, and

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transmitting to RMA within 30 days of the sales closing date.

For producers that did not submit the Request for Actuarial Change form for a BL Offer by the sales closing date deadline, a new type/practice T/P written agreement requests may be submitted until the acreage reporting date for the crop. A crop inspection may be required if the producer applies after the sales closing date. All other requirements for a T/P written agreement request apply in accordance with the Written Agreement Handbook.
