Fresh Market Bean Crop Provisions Changes Effective for the 2025 and Succeeding Crop Years

### **Background**

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) is issuing the following changes to the Fresh Market Bean crop insurance program.

For the 2025 and succeeding crop years:

- In Florida, expand insurance coverage to two counties and add a “winter” type.
- In North Carolina, allow producers to use their processing bean history to qualify for fresh market bean insurance coverage.

### **Action**

The Fresh Market Bean Crop Provisions (25-0105) will be available by close of business today on the RMA website at [www.rma.usda.gov](http://www.rma.usda.gov).

Approved insurance providers must notify policyholders of these changes at least 30 days prior to the cancellation date, as required by the policy.
