BACKGROUND:

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors approved the following changes to the Processing Pumpkin crop insurance program on May 23, 2024.

For the 2025 and succeeding crop years:

- Convert the policy from pilot to permanent status;
- Increase the maximum coverage level from 80% to 85%;
- Clarify the establishment of optional units;
- Allow enterprise units and enterprise units by organic practice; and
- Allow written agreements.

ACTION:

The Processing Pumpkin Crop Provisions (25-0147) will be available by close of business today on the Risk Management Agency (RMA) website at <u>www.rma.usda.gov</u>.

Approved insurance providers must notify policyholders of these changes at least 30 days prior to the cancellation date, as required by the policy.
