Crop Insurance Deadline Nears in Minnesota and Wisconsin for Onions

SAINT PAUL, Minn., Jan. 8, 2025 — USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds Minnesota and Wisconsin producers that the final date to apply for crop insurance for onions, is February 1 for the 2025 crop year. Current policyholders who wish to make changes to their existing coverage also have until February 1 to do so.

Federal crop insurance is critical to the farm safety net. It helps producers and owners manage revenue risks and strengthens the rural economy. Coverage for onions is available in select counties. Additional information can be found on the Actuarial Information Browser page on the RMA website.

Growers are encouraged to visit their crop insurance agent soon to learn specific details for the 2025 crop year. Additional counties may be eligible for coverage under a written agreement. Crop insurance coverage decisions must be made on or before the sales closing date.
