Production and Revenue History (PRH) Changes Effective for the 2027 and Succeeding Crop Years

BACKGROUND:

On March 5, 2026, the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors approved modifications to the PRH Strawberry Crop Provisions and PRH General Provisions, beginning with the 2027 crop year, including:

- Allowing optional units by non-contiguous land;
- Standardizing the frequency of harvest price computations;
- Clarifying how to apply the cost tolerance value when gross and actual revenues do not exist in the database; and
- Allowing written agreements.

ACTION:

- PRH Strawberry Crop Provisions (27-PRH-0154)

Approved insurance providers must notify policyholders of these changes at least 30 days prior to the cancellation date, as required by the policy.
