Dry Pea Revenue Endorsement Changes Effective for the 2027 and Succeeding Crop Years

BACKGROUND:

On May 21, 2026, to be consistent with the Common Crop Insurance Policy, Basic Provisions, as amended in the Expanding Access to Risk Protection final rule ([90 FR 54523](#)), the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) Board of Directors approved premium reimbursement for the Dry Pea Revenue Endorsement when a harvest price cannot be determined.

ACTION:

Approved Insurance Providers (AIP) must notify producers of these changes at least 30 days prior to the cancellation date, as required by the policy.
