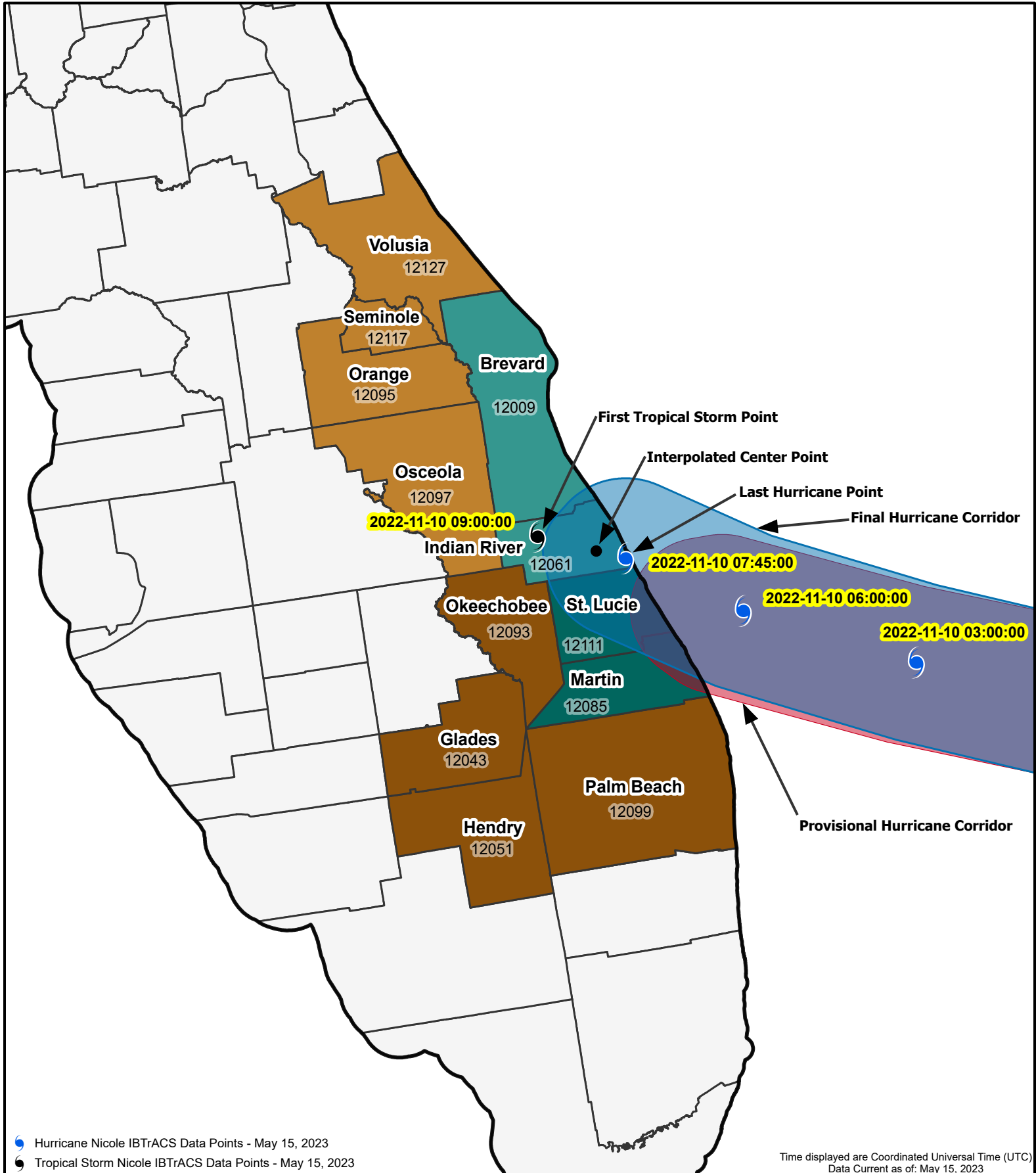

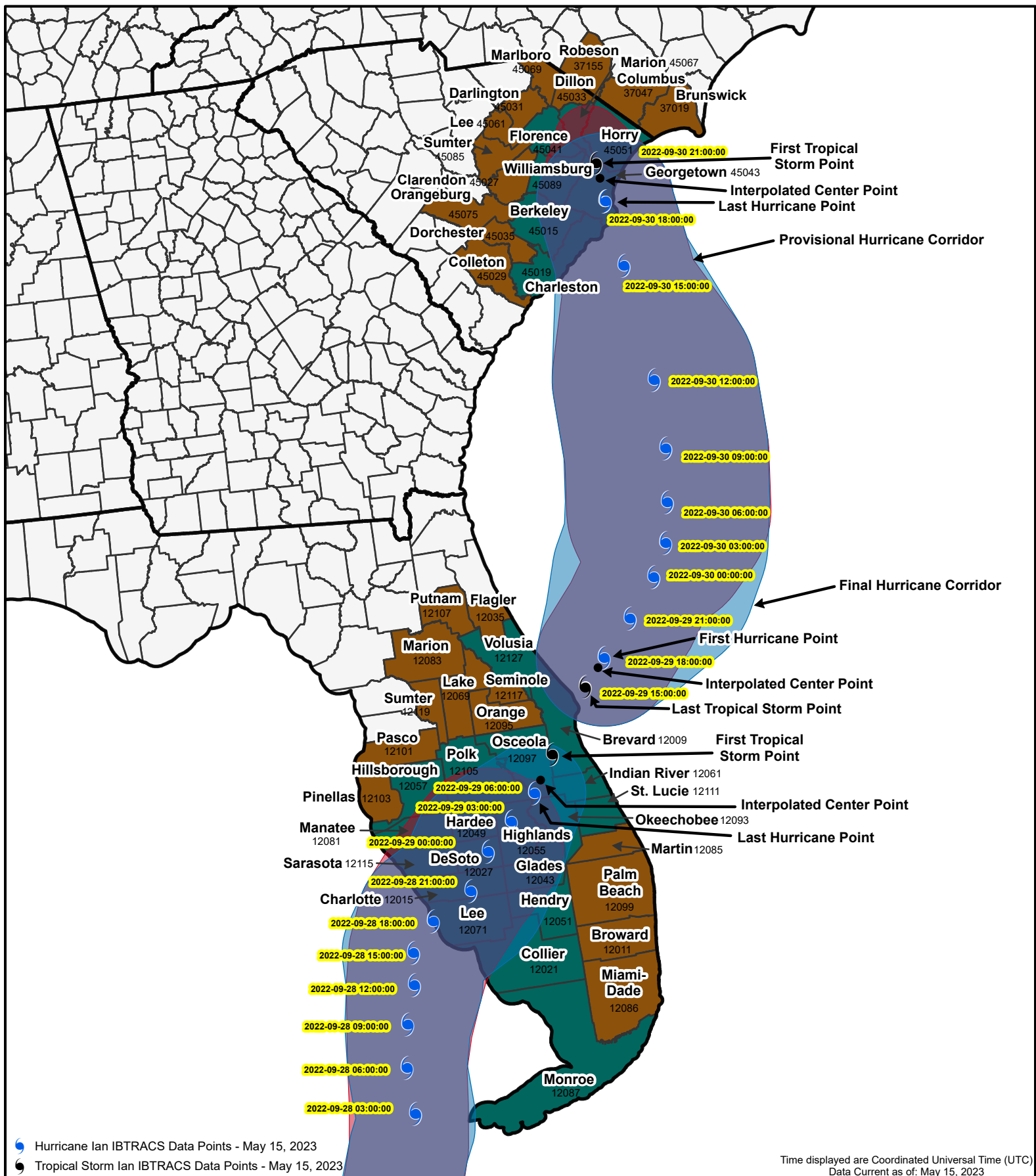
2022 Hurricane Nicole - IBTrACS

Hurricane Ian Map

The map shows the counties which triggered for payment under the Hurricane Insurance Protection – Wind Index for Hurricane Ian. In Florida, the following counties triggered: Brevard, Broward, Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Flagler, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands, Hillsborough, Indian River, Lake, Lee, Manatee, Marion, Martin, Miami-Dade, Monroe, Okeechobee, Orange, Osceola, Palm Beach, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Putman, St. Lucie, Sarasota, Seminole, Sumter, and Volusia counties. In North Carolina, the following counties triggered: Brunswick, Columbus, and Robeson counties. In South Carolina, the following Counties triggered: Berkeley, Charleston, Clarendon, Colleton, Darlington, Dillon, Dorchester, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Lee, Marion, Marlboro, Orangeburg, Sumter, and Williamsburg counties.
